## Are you dealing with challenging behaviors in your daycare? Take the New York State Pyramid Model Training!

Learn how to help children who have challenging behaviors by learning **why** children act the way they do, and learn how to provide positive individualized support for the children in your care.

The **Pyramid Model for Supporting Social-Emotional Competence in Infants and Young Children** is a conceptual framework of evidence-based practices developed by two national, federally-funded research and training centers: The Center on the Social and Emotional Foundations for Early Learning and the Technical Assistance Center on Social Emotional Intervention. These centers

represent nationally recognized researchers and program developers in the areas of social skills and challenging behavior. Based on their evaluation of data over the last eight years, the Pyramid Model has shown itself to be a sound framework for early care and education systems.

The Pyramid Model builds upon a tiered public health approach that provides universal supports to all children to promote wellness; targeted services to those who need more support; and intensive services to those who need the most support.
