

# TEACHER DIFFERENTIALS

Type	Explanation	Acceptable Credits
First Differential (C2)	30 credits above the BA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Non-transferred credits from Associate Degree</li> <li>• Excess credits from BA (Letter from Registrar required)</li> <li>• Any other credits not part of a degree</li> <li>• “G,” “C,” and “D” in-service courses</li> </ul>
Promotional Differential (PD)	1. Masters Degree	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Masters Degree irrespective of how many credits needed</li> </ul>
	2. BA + 30 credits <i>with 36 in an area of specialization (which can be part of the BA or the + 30)</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• See list of areas of specialization</li> <li>• “G” credit courses can be used</li> </ul>
Intermediate Differential (ID)	60 credits above the BA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Non-transferred credits from Associate Degree</li> <li>• Excess credits from BA (Letter from Registrar required)</li> <li>• Any other credits not part of a degree</li> <li>• “G” credit courses</li> <li>• Masters degree credits</li> </ul>
Second Differential (C6)	Earned Masters degree + 30 credits	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All credits (undergraduate or graduate) earned <b>after the date of conferral of the BA degree</b></li> <li>• A doctorate</li> <li>• Excess Masters credits (requires a letter)</li> <li>• “G” and “P” credits</li> <li>• NBPTS certification</li> </ul>
