**NEW EXHIBIT GUIDELINES:**

1. **Exhibit Boards** (black or white) 22" x 28" brought by exhibiting teacher will be placed on window grooves in the mezzanine. Boards can be foam or poster boards.
2. **Each board should be display ready** as follows:
  - a. **Label** board back with your name, school, school address, phone number
  - b. **Type a label** for board front indicating name of school and art teacher's name,
  - c. **Type a label** with student's name, and grade and place under student work.
3. **To reserve space**, by Tuesday, October 20<sup>th</sup> call **Jackie Cruz at (718) 783-0517** or e-mail at [jackiecruz5@yahoo.com](mailto:jackiecruz5@yahoo.com). Leave your name, school, phone number and number of display boards you will submit. (maximum of four boards per teacher)
4. **A short typed sheet** explaining the problem/question students had to respond to, motivation, and procedural and assessment strategies. This sheet should be mounted like the student work. (**\*WITHOUT THIS TYPED INFORMATION, WORK WILL NOT BE DISPLAYED.**)
5. **Mail** prepared boards (exhibit ready) **October 13-October 21** to the school c/o Mark Law/ NYCATA/UFT, Art Dept., Room 761, LaGuardia High School of the Arts (108 Amsterdam Ave., NYC 10023) or **bring it by Friday, Oct. 23rd by 5:00 p.m.** All boards will be hung by NYCATA/UFT Student Exhibit Committee Members.
6. All art work must be taken at the end of the conference beginning at 3:30pm
