Contract Article 7:

At that time, teachers should be given an opportunity to fill out "preference sheets" indicating three preferences in order of priority of grade level and type of class on that level or, in the case of special education teachers, the age range of special education classes and education program designation (e.g. staffing ratio, collaborative team teaching, SETSS, etc.) with the understanding that, where advisable and possible, such preferences will be honored. Teachers should be given an opportunity to discuss their assignment requests with their principal.

SBO:

(School) would like to modify the contract as follows:

At that time, teachers should be given an opportunity to fill out "preference sheets" indicating three preferences in order of priority of grade level, department, and type of class on that level, or, in the case of special education teachers, the age range of special education classes and education program designation (e.g. staffing ratio, collaborative team teaching, SETSS, etc.) with the understanding that, where advisable and possible, such preferences will be honored. Teachers should be given an opportunity to discuss their assignment requests with their principal.

This would allow departmentalization for Grades 4 and 5 for ELA, Math, Social Studies, and Science.

The programs of each teacher will be as follows:

Teacher A: Has homeroom Class 501, teaches ELA to both 501 and 502 and teaches Social Studies and Science only to Class 501

Teacher B: Has homeroom Class 502, teaches MATH to both 501 and 502 and teaches Social Studies and Science only to Class 502

Teacher C: Has homeroom Class 401, teaches Math to both 401 and 402 and teaches Social Studies and Science only to Class 401

Teacher D: Has homeroom Class 402, teaches ELA to both 401 and 402 and teaches Social Studies and Science only to Class 402

The Special Education Teachers (ICT) will follow their respective grade band.
