Fall Literacy and Math Intervention Training

As a follow-up to the August 10 edition of [Principals Digest](#), the DOE is continuing to provide virtual elementary and secondary intervention training this fall, from 8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., beginning the week of **October 4** through **November 12**. Principals are encouraged to [nominate](#) one special education teacher and one paraprofessional to receive training by **September 30**; nominees will then be registered for one training session. When nominating staff, note that they should not have attended the prior trainings in [May](#) or [August](#). Additionally, priority should be given to a special education teacher and designated paraprofessional who can support the classroom teacher in delivering Special Education Recovery services and interventions to their students for the 2021–22 school year during the instructional school day and/or during recovery afterschool and weekend programs.

Note that schools will receive funding to purchase intervention materials and provide coverage for staff to attend the one day of training. The DOE will be hosting virtual office hours for special education teachers and paraprofessionals with questions, or suggestions for successful intervention implementation.
