Worlds AIDS Day Student Poster Contest

UFT Team High School in collaboration with the UFT BRAVE Program is sponsoring a student poster contest to bring awareness and commemorate World AIDS day on December 1, 2017. The contest is open to all New York City Public school students in grades 9 – 12.

Approximately 8,123 adults and adolescents were diagnosed with HIV in New York in 2015. The purpose of World AIDS Day is to bring awareness of “opportunity for people worldwide to unite in the fight against HIV, show support for people living with HIV and to commemorate people who have died.”
