- ▶ Each speech provider can submit up to two (2) projects with a maximum of three students and three speech providers per project (No groups of 5, NO exceptions).
- ▶ Send us the best work from your student caseload.
- ▶ Make sure the nominating form is complete and timely.
- ▶ Everyone can be nominated but priority will be given to new participants in the competition.



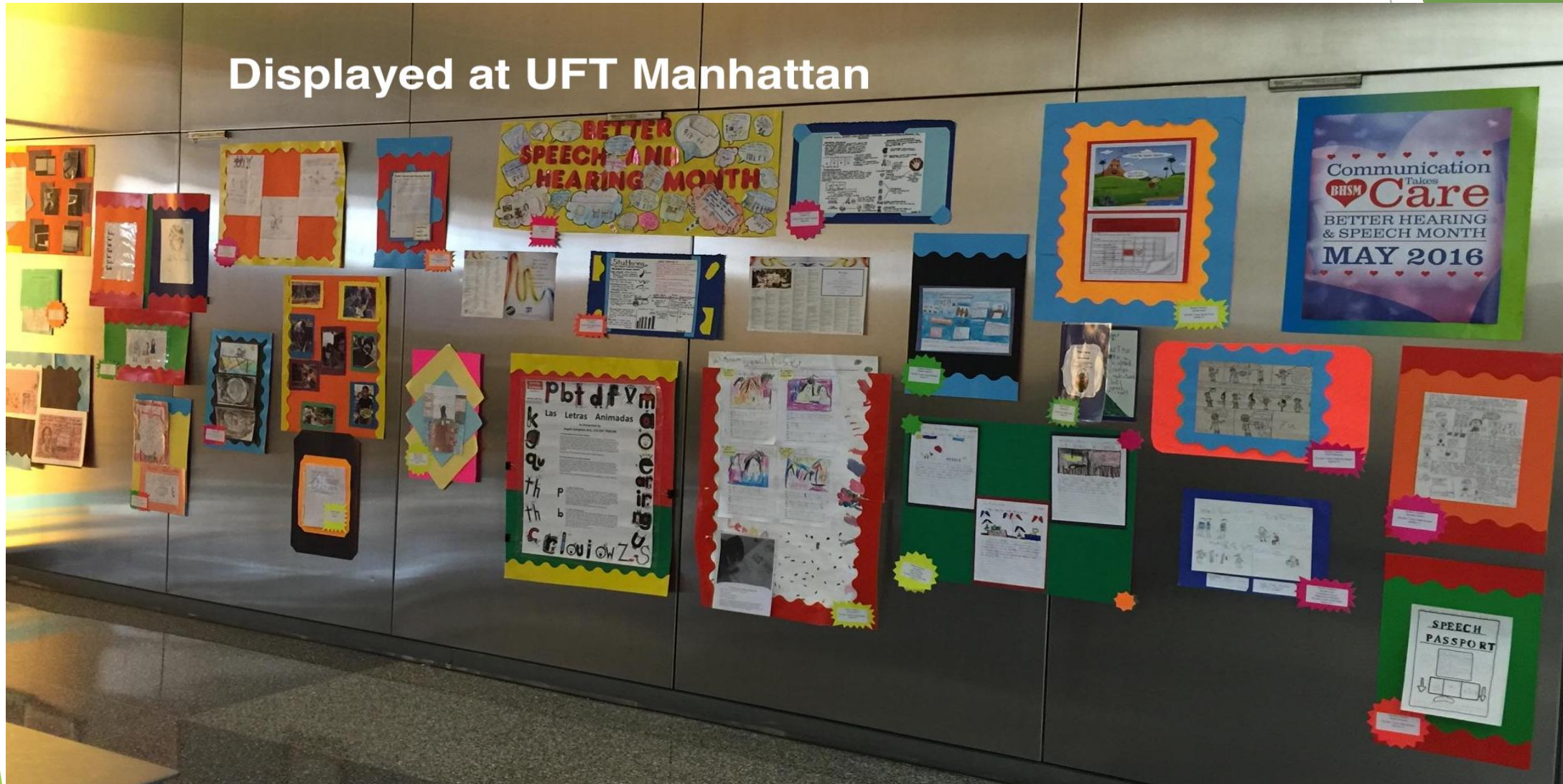

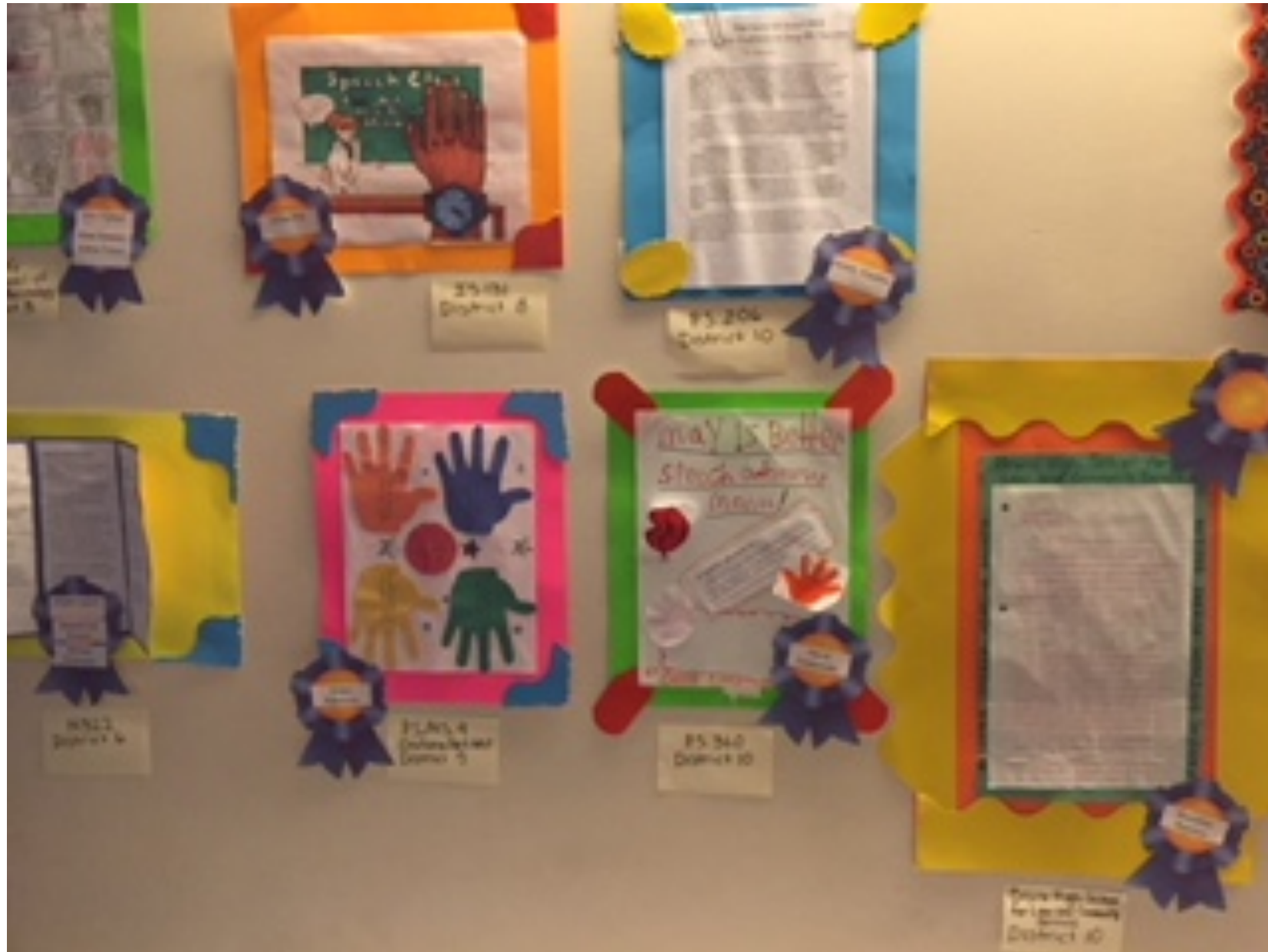
