Are there Permission Slips and Forms?

Yes, there are four forms, and an attendance sheet which must be filled out prior to Field Day.

MANDATORY FORMS:

1. 2018 Pathways to Graduation Field Day Trip Plan Riverbank State Park: To be filled out by the teacher-in-charge and sent to your assistant principal or principal.
 2. 2018 Pathways to Graduation Field Day Parent Notification Consent Form for Riverbank State Park: To be signed by the student or parent if student is 17.
 3. 2018 Pathways to Graduation Field Day Media Consent Form for Riverbank State Park: To be signed by the student or parent if student is 17.
 4. 2018 Pathways to Graduation Field Day Behavior Contract Riverbank State Park: *To be signed by each student after the teacher has fully reviewed its contents with their students*
 5. Attendance Sheets: The Teacher-in-Charge will be responsible for taking attendance before leaving their sites on the morning of Field Day. This form is to be given to Field Day staff upon arrival
- Upon arrival, the Teacher -in-Charge of the group of students will provide Field Day staff with **ONLY the Attendance roster**. **The Teacher-in-Charge is to bring and keep with them, the Parent Notification Consent Form** should staff need to contact a parent or guardian during the day. All other forms are to remain at the site.

- Field Day Staff will provide the Teacher -in-Charge with wristbands for the students. These ID bracelets which are to be worn all day. The bracelets signify that the person is a registered Pathways to Graduation student. Only those individuals with a bracelet will be given a Field Day Shirt and lunch.

How do we get there?

1. School Bus: Buses have been ordered for The Manhattan HUB, The Tenzer Learning Center, The St. George HUB, The Linden Learning Center, The Marcy HUB, South Shore, Brooklyn Y-Roads, Schemerhorn, The Jamaica Learning Center, Mary Mitchell, and the Bronx Regional High School. Please inquire with either your assistant principal or their designee for more information.
2. Subway:
 1. The 1 Train to either the 145th Street Station or the 137th Street Station
 2. The A, C, B, or D to the 145th Street Station. (Walk West, 4 blocks from St. Nicholas Ave to Riverside Drive.)
3. MTA Bus:
 1. BX 19. Stops within the park.
 2. M 11. Stops within the park.

What are the responsibilities of Staff?

1. Site staff, along with their AP are to ensure that any students who are not attending Field Day are provided a regular instructional day.

2. The Teacher-in-Charge of the class trip to Riverbank and any accompanying staff members are to follow the NYC DOE's field trip protocols as outlined in the Chancellor's Regulations.
3. Attendance sheets are to be handed to Field Day staff upon arrival.
4. To ensure the safety of our students it is important for all staff to remember that every student is our responsibility, not just those from our individual sites. If you see any Pathways to Graduation student in need of assistance or is not behaving appropriately, please act.
