STARI (Strategic Adolescent Reading Intervention) is a literature- focused, Tier II intervention for students in grades 6-9 who are reading 2-4 years below grade level. Using research- based practices and highly engaging texts, STARI addresses gaps in fluency, decoding, reading stamina, and reading comprehension. This session is an introduction to STARI and will provide you with the training needed to begin implementation of the STARI program. All of STARI’s student and teacher materials are free and downloadable.
