Split Professional Activity Assignments (4 days of one activity, 1 of another)

Contract:

Article 7: Teachers shall select each spring (following the timeframe for program preferences listed under Articles 7A, 7B, 7C, and 7K in this Agreement) in priority order, three (3) activities from the menu they want to participate in for the following school year. The principal shall make assignments based on qualifications and availability of positions. If more teachers seek particular activities than positions are available, the principal shall select the most qualified teacher(s); and if the candidates are equally qualified the candidate with the most school seniority will be selected. To the extent possible each teacher shall receive one of the three (3) activities for the following school year. If this is not possible, the teacher will be given the opportunity to select three (3) additional choices, one of which will be granted, subject to qualifications, and unless sufficient teachers do not choose a particular activity. If sufficient teachers do not choose a particular activity with any of their six (6) choices, the Principal will assign teachers to these activities on a rotational basis in inverse seniority order with no teacher being involuntarily assigned to an administrative activity for consecutive years.

SBO:

Teachers at (School Name) must select a professional or administrative activity in accordance with this section and the provisions of Article 7U (Professional Activity Assignment Procedures)

Teachers will perform this activity 4 days of the week.

On the other day, they will use their professional period for common planning.

The principal shall ensure that each teacher's program provides for one period per week during which each teacher will meet with a colleague in her or his department. If the principal should fail to ensure that such an opportunity exists, the teacher shall be relieved of the responsibility to participate in common planning and will instead have an additional preparatory period. For all teachers with ICT classes, the principal shall ensure that the common planning period allows ICT partners to meet.

Common planning shall be a professional assignment, and shall not require the submission of minutes, unit plans, goals, or any other paperwork that could, in any way, be construed as an accountability measure related to common planning.
